Road to 2027: The FICB International Congress takes shape!

With two years to go until the event, the Fédération suisse des confréries bachiques et gastronomiques (FSCBG) held a seminar the define the major milestones in organising the 53rd FICB International Congress, scheduled for May 2027. This was a valuable opportunity to assess the current progress and collaboratively shape what aims to be an exceptional event on the shores of Lake Léman and Lake Neuchâtel, and in the Valais and Fribourg regions.

The countdown has begun! During a two-day seminar, members of the Organising Committee came together to accelerate preparations for the future FICB International Congress, which will be held in Switzerland from 6 to 13 May 2027.

This inaugural strategic meeting marked a significant milestone in shaping the event.
